RE: POLICY CHANGE ON STUDENT DRESS
DATE: October 27, 2011

Please be informed that on October 26, 2011 the Board of Trustees approved a policy change on student dress code – outerwear, 2011-12 Student/Parent Handbook, page 41. The current policy states: “Hooded sweatshirts (with or without zipper) are not allowed during academic hours or at academic functions, banquets, or other school sponsored events.”

The new policy effective today, October 27, 2011, has been amended to read as follows:

“Hooded sweatshirts (with or without zipper) are allowed during academic hours as long as the hoods are not worn in the school buildings and as long as the hoodies are appropriate and reflect the school in a positive image, i.e, Eagle Mascot/Athletics. Students are required to abide by all other dress code policies.”

This policy change was initiated and presented in a convincing and professional manner by Student Senate. The Board members acknowledge the students for utilizing their government to make changes that impact them. Thank you for your understanding of the policy change.
