RE: RESIDENTIAL Check-in/Checklist for Homes

Dear Eagle Student and Family,

Good day from Navajo Preparatory School. We look forward to welcoming you for SY23/24. Our Residential Check-In begins on August 13, 2023 for all new incoming residential students. *Day students will commute daily for New Student Orientation.*

We will contact you on a specific time for check-in as we move closer to your student being on campus. Below is information that will make the check-in process smooth on that day. A friendly reminder, the road North of the campus will be closed due to construction of our new Residential Home.

- Please note that there will be no parking by Arthur Hall.
- The gym parking lot will be utilized for all Residential Homes during check-in. This is for student/parent safety and to avoid traffic congestion in this area.
- You will be receiving an email from your Residential Advisors next week to inform you of your room number in the Residential Home that you will be residing in.
- All Magnus medical information MUST be completed *before* moving into the Residential Homes.

Residential Supplies:

- Two combination locks (Our Residential Program is not responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged items; therefore, students are required to bring two combination locks at the time of check-in.)
- Facial mask(s), (Optional)
- Comforter or quilt (Consider bringing sturdy, easy-to-wash items)
- Throw Blanket
- Bed linens and pillow (Suggested Size: Twin XL)
- Mattress pad/cover
- Alarm clock
- Bath towels, washcloths, and hand towels. Consider putting your name on a tag in permanent marker, especially if you have plain white or other anonymous towels.
- Shower shoes
- Shower bucket/basket/caddy to carry items
- Storage container with a lid for snack items
- Standing Fans or Desk fans
- Personal Hygiene Items

- Approved medication (must be checked into a Residential Advisor, including Epi-Pens). Please, no excessive amounts of prescription, over-the-counter medicines, and vitamins. Please Notify Residential staff and SBHC of medications. Please make sure prescription medications are not outdated.
- Learning supplies: Per Dean of Instructions and on the website.
- Water bottle
- Small desk lamp
- Laundry Detergent with coins (Quarters)
- Laundry hamper or bag
- Surge protector
- Chargers for electronic devices,
- Traditional Dress outfits for cultural events/activities.
- Batteries AA/AAA
- Plastic utensils, forks, knives, and spoons

7 Day Students:

- Extra bedding, mattress cover (2 sets for transitioning to program)

The Navajo Preparatory School Residential Program will continue to ensure that all appropriate safety precautions are in place for your student's wellness. Please remind your student to be responsible and always follow all safety measures and protocols.
