RE: RESIDENTIAL Check-in/Checklist for Homes

Dear Eagle Student and Family,

Good day from Navajo Preparatory School! We look forward to welcoming you back for SY 25-26! Below is information that will hopefully make your check-in process easier on that day. Your Residential advisor will be contacting you in the next few weeks to notify you of which home you'll be living in for the next few years. Please keep an eye on your email and website for additional school information in the next few weeks.

- Check-in for Male Homes (Arthur/Manuelito): there will be no parking by Arthur Hall for student/parent safety and to avoid car pileups in this area.
- Carts will be available to transport your student items safely to and from the Homes from the parking area. This will be set up on the day of Check-In. Limited parking by Fitness Center and for ADA.
- Check-in for Female Homes (Zah/Bates/Garrett): The parking area is in the gym parking lot.
- You will be receiving an email from your Residential Advisors next week to inform you of your room number and Residential home that you will be residing in for the year.
- All Magnus medical information MUST be completed before moving into the Residential Homes.

As a reminder, please bring the following items for the first day of school:

- Two combination locks (Our Residential Program is not responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged items; therefore, students are required to bring two combination locks at the time of check-in.)
- Comforter and quilts (Consider bringing sturdy, easy-to-wash items)
- Throw Blanket
- Bed sheets (Suggested Size: Twin XL)
- Pillows and Pillowcases
- Mattress pad/cover
- Alarm clock
- Bath towels, washcloths, and hand towels. Consider putting your name on a tag in permanent marker, especially if you have plain white or other "anonymous" towels.
- Shower shoes (Community Showers)
- Shower bucket/basket/caddy to carry items
- Closed containers for snack items with a lid
- Standing Fans or Desk fans
- Personal Hygiene Items





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- Approved medication (must be checked into a Residential Advisor, including Epi-Pens). Please, no excessive amounts of prescription, over-the-counter medicines, and vitamins. Please Notify Residential staff and SBHC of medications. Please make sure prescription medications are not outdated.
- Learning supplies: Per Dean of Instructions and on the website.
- Water bottle/hydro flask
- Small desk lamp
- Laundry Detergent
- Laundry hamper or bag
- Surge protector
- Chargers for electronic devices,
- Traditional Dress outfits for cultural events/activities.
- Batteries AA/AAA
- Plastic utensils, forks, knives, and spoons
- If athlete footpowder

We are excited to have you be a part of our residential program this school year. NPS Residential Homes will continue to ensure that all appropriate safety precautions are still in place for your student's wellness. We ask students to be responsible and always follow all safety measures/safety protocols. And a final reminder if you came off the wait list last year during the school year you will automatically place back as a Day student per the NPS handbook.
